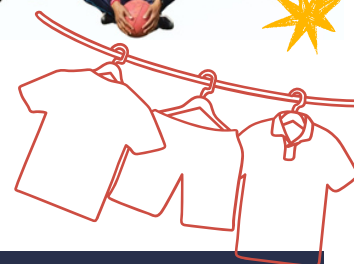


Term 3 Sport

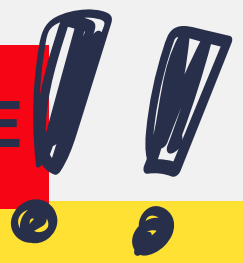
