Tips needed shopping for stationery... FAQ



1. What scissor do I buy?

- Your child is right-handed – Buy a right-handed scissor
- Your child is left-handed – Buy a left-handed scissor
- Not sure what hand is dominant – Buy an ambidextrous scissor



2. What is a Zip Plastic Envelope?

This is to safely store your child's books in their bag without worrying about anything getting wet or damaged. Please look for a PLASTIC envelope with a zip.

3. What puzzles do I buy?

Please look for a sturdy wood base puzzle that can be packed away in its own box. Cardboard puzzles easily bend and break.

Please note that lasting items will be returned at the end of the year. Anything that has been used or has been damaged cannot be returned.
